With its stylish and attractive design, the MEMOday blends in well with any home décor. Place the MEMOday in an area where you spend a lot of time. This could be in the bedroom, next to the phone or on the kitchen counter.

The information shown on the display is easy to read, with large text and high contrast. The screen can display black text on a white background or white text on a black background - whatever works best for you.

Many people find it easier to retain details when they take in visual and aural information simultaneously. That's why the MEMOday also has a display reader function. With a light press on the display, the MEMOday reads what is displayed out loud.



EASY TO USE

You can customise what information is displayed on the screen based on your own needs. With the help of an assistant or relative, you can choose whether you want to show an analogue or digital clock, and an overview of whether it is morning, mid-morning, afternoon, evening, or night.

If your MEMOday is unplugged from the wall, the back-up battery will save all your settings. When plugged back in, the correct date and time will be shown automatically. You can always rely on the MEMOday.

The MEMOday is currently available in 26 different languages.
